## Gymnasts Welcome Utah for Senior Night

PROVO, Utah (March 27, 2007) – After posting a season-best 195.675 mark in a tri-meet win last week, the No. 24 Cougar gymnasts will look to carry that momentum into Friday's regular-season finale and senior night when they take on No. 6 Utah.

With a spot in the NCAA Regionals firmly in place, BYU is looking to improve its Regional Qualifying Score (RQS) and head into regional competition on a high note. The Cougars currently carry an RQS of 194.775 and are competing with Minnesota, who holds an identical 194.775 RQS, for the fourth spot in the North Central Region. The top six teams will move on to Regionals on April 14.

"It is important for us to score the best we can," BYU coach Brad Cattermole said. "We need to get the best score we can to get the best seeding possible. Having a good team like Utah to compete against brings your scores up. We couldn't ask for a better situation at this point in the season."

BYU moved up two spots in the latest national rankings released by Troester Consulting Monday morning. The Cougars are ranked No. 20 on beam and No. 24 on bars. Dayna Smart is ranked No. 20 on beam and is tied with teammate Alethea Boon for a No. 29 ranking on vault.

BYU tumbled to its best floor score of the season at 49.450 last weekend. Smart recorded the second-highest floor mark in school history at 9.975, while four other gymnasts also notched career-best marks on the event. The Cougars also posted their best bars score of the season (49.000) behind career-high marks from Boon and Kylee Draper.

The national-power Utes are coming into Friday's meet with an RQS of 196.545 and a win over No. 25 Arizona State last week. Utah is ranked No. 3 on bars and No. 5 on vault. The Utes are led by All-Americans Nicolle Ford, Kristina Baskett and Ashley Postell.

After the meet, seniors Kacie Capra-Callens and Lisa Willis will be honored. The two standouts have left their marks on the BYU program over the last few years. Both are former team captains that have recorded scores that rank among the best in school history. Capra-Callens holds the school's second-highest bars score (9.950), and Willis has the fifth-best floor mark (9.950) in Cougar history.

Start time is scheduled for 7 p.m. in the Marriott Center. The meet will be shown live on BYUTV and live stats will be available on the women's gymnastics homepage at www.byucougars.com.

## Cougar Notes

### Rankings

The Cougars are ranked No. 24 nationally in the latest polls released Monday morning. Unlike other sports, gymnastics rankings are based on compilations of a team's scores. For further info., see the next page.

### Season Record

Counting wins in dual meets and its finishes in multiple-team meets, BYU now has a 11-7 record on the season.

### Team Canada in Provo

Danielle Goldman, Melissa Hough and Jenna Kerbis have all represented their native Canada in international meets before coming to BYU. Kerbis is the most recent, having helped lead the Canadian National Team to a bronze medal at the 2006 Commonwealth Games in Melbourne, Australia. Goldman competed for Canada at the 2005 Maccabbi Games in Israel, finishing third in the all-around and helping team Canada to a Silver Medal. Hough was a member of the Canadian National Team as a novice and junior and finished second in the all-around at an international meet in Belgium in 2005.

### Trading Uniforms

Redshirt-freshman Megan Perner came to BYU in 2005 on a track and field scholarship. However, her first love in athletics as a child was gymnastics. After a series of tryouts and rigorous summer training, she walked on to the team. This season marks the first time in seven years she has competed in gymnastics.

### She Can't Hear You

Junior Aimee Walker Pond is blind in her right eye and deaf in both ears. Many of the girls on the team and the coaches know at least some sign language to be able to communicate with her.

### Cougars vs Utah

BYU will face Utah for the second time this season and the 82nd time in the history of the program. The Utes hold a 79-2 advantage in the series. The last time the Cougars topped the Utes was in 1998 in the Marriott Center. The two in-state competitors met earlier this season at a quad meet at the Huntsman Center in Salt Lake City. Utah finished with a 196.150 to BYU's 192.600.

### Vault

The Cougars are ranked 32nd in the nation on the event. Their highest team score of the season is a 49.050. Dayna Smart and Alethea Boon have led the team in every meet this season. Boon posted a team-best 9.950, which tied the seventh-highest mark in school history, against Texas Woman's.

### Bars

BYU's highest score of the season is a 49.000. The Cougars are ranked 24th in the nation on the event. Juniors Boon and Kylee Draper have posted the teams highest scores at 9.875. Kacie Capra-Callens is right behind at 9.850. Three others have posted 9.825s.

### Beam

The beam squad is ranked 20th in the nation. BYU recorded a season-best 49.125 against Utah State on Jan. 22. Smart has the highest score of the season at 9.950, tying the eighth-best mark in school history. She is ranked 20th in the nation on the event. Six of the eight competitors that have been in the lineup this season have posted a 9.800 or better.

### Floor

The Cougars highest score of the season is 49.450. BYU is ranked 26th in the nation on the event. Smart tied the second-best mark in school history with a 9.975 last weekend. Six competitors have posted scores of at least 9.850.

### All-Around

Smart and Boon have been the only all-around competitors this season. Smart has five all-around titles in six meets competing on every event. Boon has posted a 39.225 and has one all-around title.

### Injury Update

Freshman Megan Perner is questionable with a foot injury.

**Floor Raises BYU in Tri Meet**

*Dayna Smart ties Second-Best Floor Mark in School History*

PROVO, Utah (Mar. 23, 2007) -- BYU saved the best for last to defeat No. 14 Arizona and No. 34 Southern Utah in a tri meet in the Marriott Center Friday night. Scoring a season-high 49.450 on floor in the final rotation, the 26th-rated Cougars came from behind for the win.

BYU finished the meet with a 195.675 score, followed by Arizona at 195.300 and Southern Utah at 194.875. The highlight of the night was delivered by BYU's Dayna Smart, who tied the second-best floor score in the history of BYU gymnastics with a 9.975 performance.

BYU scored 48.675 on vault to open the meet with Smart equaling her career high with a 9.900 effort to lead the Cougars. Hayley Jensen also posted her best vault of the year with a 9.775.

The Cougars recorded their best score of the year on bars (49.000) in the second rotation thanks to five solid performances. Kylee Draper tied her career high and Boon set her person best as both scored 9.875 to lead the way. Kacie Capra-Callens followed at 9.825.

The best beam performance for the Cougars was a 9.800 delivered by Smart, who ranks 17th nationally on the event.

BYU saved the best for last as it started strong on floor with freshmen gymnasts Heidi Poulson and Kiki Berrett both achieving personal bests of 9.850. Willis followed with a season-high 9.925 and Draper earned the team's third 9.850, a career best for the junior co-captain, before Smart stepped up and delivered a floor routine that has only been topped once (Brogan Jacobsen's perfect 10 in 2003) in the history of BYU gymnastics. The floor score pushed BYU to the win.

**Boon, Floor Lift Cougars in Colorado**

DENVER, Colo. (March 16, 2007) -- Alethea Boon picked up the first all-around victory of her career with a 39.100, and the No. 22 Cougar gymnasts tumbled to their second-highest mark of the season on floor to help BYU to a 193.800 outing at a triangular meet Friday in Colorado.

The Cougars came in third place behind No. 17 Denver, who recorded a 196.100, and Pac-10 competitor California at 193.875.

BYU welcomed the return of senior Kacie Capra-Callens to the bars lineup after she sat out last weekend to nurse an ankle injury. The Kingwood, Texas, native swung to a 9.775 to tie freshman teammate McKell Poulson for team-high honors on the event. Kylee Draper was close behind with a 9.750, while Lisa Willis tied a season-best 9.725 for the Cougars.

Hayley Jensen turned in a good night on beam with a career-high 9.775 to lead BYU in its second rotation. Alethea Boon was also strong with a 9.750 to finish right behind Jensen. However, the event that has been one of the Cougars' best the last two years ended up being the one that gave them the most problems Friday night.

A pair of career highs from two freshmen helped the Cougars to a 48.925 on floor to get back on track in the third rotation. First-year competitors Heidi Poulson and Danielle Goldman tumbled to career-best marks of 9.800 and 9.750, respectively, to start things off. Dayna Smart picked up a 9.800. Boon led the way for the Cougars on the event with a 9.825, the second-best mark of her career.

Boon led BYU on vault with a 9.850 in the last rotation. Smart was just behind with a 9.800. Jenna Kerbis turned in a solid 9.700 for the Cougars.

Boon picked up the highest total score over the four events to come in first place in the all-around.
